Survey conducted online in early June 2022 with 217 accounting and finance professionals sourced from the Precision Sample panel. The study was timed to launch right after the July close.








# Professional Experience

# Distribution of **Company Stage**




# Ch. 1 Controller's Guidebook Recap: The Burnout is Real

## Accountants Everywhere are Experiencing Burnout

Our adaptation and application of the MBI showed 99% experienced some level of burnout with 38% above average levels of burnout and 20% of them experiencing high levels of burnout.

#### **Burnout Score** Distribution



#### Burnout and Job Satisfaction

Just over half of accountants with low levels of burnout are extremely satisfied with their jobs.

Just under 40% of accountants with high levels of burnout are extremely satisfied with their jobs.

# Percent Satisfied with their Jobs According to Burnout Score



### **Burnout and Life Disruption**

Almost 2/3 of accountants with high levels of burnout strongly agree that their close process conflicts with their personal relationships.

Only 20% of accountants with low burnout feel this way.



#### **Burnout and Accuracy**

High levels of burnout result in reopening the books about twice as often as low levels of burnout.

# Ch. 2 Controller's Guidebook: Uncovering the Drivers of Burnout

## What stood out?

The relationship an accountant has with their technology matters.

#### The Three Relationship Types



In **Adversarial** relationships, technology is seen as a hindrance rather than a help.



In **Routine** relationships, technology is functional but doesn't add value to their work or life.



In **Synergistic** relationships, technology is a true partner in the accountant's work.



#### **Adversarial Relationship**

First, there is the Adversarial relationship in which the technology is seen as a hindrance rather than a resource. The accountant experiences a mix of dread and forced acceptance knowing they have to use this technology. It doesn't function the way the accountant or guiding principles require. The accountant must find ways to manipulate the technology or perform redundant work to ensure the job gets done.



#### **Routine Relationship**

Second, there is the **Routine** relationship in which the technology works but adds minimal value. It might encourage the accounting professional to take a basic or functional approach to their job or — conversely — force them to be creative, independent of the prime directive of the technology. The accountant can think like the technology cannot think like the modern accountant.



#### **Synergistic Relationship**

Finally, there is the **Synergistic** relationship in which the technology becomes an extension of the accountant. In this relationship, it is difficult to tell where the accountant's efforts end and the technology's efforts begin. **The** technology (or, more correctly, the people who designed the technology) has an intimate understanding of how accountants think and work and supports what the accountant is trying to achieve. The accountant benefits from having a true partner in their work.









An integrated technology solution has a much greater impact on the relationship the accountant has with their technology than an integrated technology system


# **Integrated Technology Score**Distribution

Belief That You Have Enough Time To Complete Your Work by Technology Relationship Type


