How Does an Instructional Video on TiKTok work?

- 1. Create a video on your preferred notes app or PDF markup app with a mobile device screen recording feature using ...
 - App Good Notes 5 app
 - Mobile Device iPad Pro & Apple Pencil 2 **



**Alternative - An android device may be used to screen record and other note-taking (MS notes or Evernote) apps may be used in lieu of Apple products.

Video Created Using Good Notes 5 . . .

Screen recording without sound of me creating a 'T' – account.

Real-time 20 seconds.



How Does an Instructional Video on TiKTok work?

2. Upload to TikTok App

- a. Double or triple time video speed to keep it under a minute (update: three minutes maximum currently allowed).
- b. Add optional sound.
 - i. Background music
 - ii. Voiceover narrative
- c. Add the video description and complete the upload.



Launch the TikTok App

a. Double or triple time video speed to keep it under a minute (update: three minute maximum currently allowed).



Video Speed

See the difference in the speed for 1x or 3x...



45 PM Mon Jul 5

Don't forget the goal is one minute or less.

Some videos may require multiple parts if longer than a minute or consider using the app's new feature of allowing a 3-minute maximum.

b. Add Optional Sound: Background music ...



Select optional background music with out words and longer than video.

Lower original sound to 0% and 5-7% volume for optional background music.



b. Add Optional Sound: Voiceover Narrative ...

Add the optional voiceover narrative to explain each step. Select the 'Voiceover' icon in the upper right hand corner.

3. Automatically saves video to your local device* and uploads to Instagram.







*must turn on the "save to device" option under the TikTok advanced settings.

4. Then upload to Twitter from Instagram.

Share Link on Your LMS

5. Post the TikTok link to your course's learning management system [LMS] to allow students to see the video whether they have a TikTok account or not.

Benefits to Creating TikTok Videos . . .

- 1. Provide feedback to students
- 2. Demonstrate the steps used in deriving the solution
- 3. Combine similar shorter videos to create longer videos
- 4. View on a mobile device or a computer
- 5. Challenge students to create video responses

Things I've Learned Using TikTok

- 1. Keep my personal and educational accounts separate
- 2. Don't follow anyone on my educational account.
- 3. Make sure my words on my T-shirts or behind me are mirrored when live recording.
- 4. Remember to check inbox for comments from viewers.
- 5. Branding helps find my videos. (I use the hashtag #LearnAccountingToday .)
- 6. There are too many features in the TikTok app to learn them all... keep it simple!





Drawbacks to Posting Video to TikTok . . .

- 1. Public posts allow everyone to view your videos.
- 2. Not all students are accustomed to using social media.
- 3. There may be students not in your class asking questions. (Depending on how you look at it, this might be an benefit!)

Summary Steps . . .

- 1. Screen capture or record video on a mobile device
- 2. Upload to TikTok
- 3. Automatically upload to Instagram^{*}
- 4. Upload to Twitter*
- 5. Share the TikTok video link* in your course LMS ... You are done!

*Alternatively, upload the video to your YouTube channel.
